Present your work to the public in an amazing space! Think state-of-the-art lighting, beautiful white walls, flexible, practical display plinths and floor-to-ceiling windows facing Dixon Street.

Whether you're a recent graduate, an emerging independent artist, a company, organisation, or a more established artist, you are encouraged to apply. Our creative development opportunities usually have emerging artists and companies top-of-mind, but larger organisations may apply too. We acknowledge that it's tough for everyone at the moment. If you have a cohort of like-minded artists in your life whom you'd like to share wall space with, feel free to join forces and submit a group proposal.

What will Te Auaha Provide?

- Te Auaha Gallery exhibition space, ground floor Te Auaha (65 Dixon Street, Te Aro).
- Use of our plinths and moveable walls.
- A technician to focus the gallery lights for you once your works are installed. We have 22 Selecon Display Lighting Accent LED Beamspots.
- Insurance for all exhibited work.
- Assistance with exhibition promotion and publicity.
- Wi-fi, support, advice, and smiles.

What do we expect?

- Value the opportunity and make the most of it!
- All works need to be ready for hanging and/or placement. You'll also need to provide any equipment you need to mount or hang your work, e.g. hanging materials and tools.
- Eagerness to self-promote and get behind marketing and networking. Don't be shy to tell people why your exhibition is unmissable.
- You will be responsible for managing the installation and de-installation of your exhibited works (with our advice and guidance, of course).

How can I apply?

Email our Producer, Olivia, with an outline of your proposed exhibition and some images of your work. Your proposal doesn't need to be formal; feel free to include a creative CV or anything else you think would be relevant. What happens once applications close on 2 April?

- A panel made up of three Te Auaha staff will assess all the applications. We may get in touch before final decisions are made, to clarify details or check your requirements.
- Successful applicants will be sent a hire agreement to read through and sign off.
- We will notify all applicants of the outcome by 5pm on Friday 5th April 2024.
